Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons

Belize became the latest state to sign the Treaty, doing so at the United Nations in February taking the number to 81. Of those states 35 have completed the domestic process needed to ratify the Treaty, which will come into force once a further 15 states have done so. The nuclear-armed states, including the UK, continue to ignore the Treaty and have not engaged at any level to date.

- Thank God for the work of the United Nations towards nuclear disarmament
- Thank God for the 35 states that have ratified the Ban Treaty
- Pray that the remaining 15 states needed to bring the Treaty into force would ratify
